The Hellenic Mediterranean University (HMU) established on 2019 as a continuation and upgrade of the ex-Technological Educational Institute of Crete. The University has been transformed from an Applied Sciences University to a Research University (the law allows the HMU to offer PhD degrees). The HMU has campuses all over Crete, with the main campus to be based in Heraklion. It contains five schools with 11 Departments. More particular the five Schools and the 11 functioning Departments of HMU are (1) School of Health Sciences: Department of Social Work, Nursing Department.
